Exhibition of Alexandra Athanassiades' artwork until the 31st of August

Alexandra Athanassiades' higher education began in Switzerland at Lugano's Franklin College. In 1982 she graduated with distinction from Oxford University's Ruskin School of Drawing and Fine Art at St. Anne's College and was awarded a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Sculpture and Print Making. In 1984 she received a Master of Fine Arts degree in Sculpture from Columbia University, New York. Her work has been exhibited in many solo and group exhibitions in Greece, Paris, New York, Connecticut, Brussels, London, and Monte Carlo. Her



sculptures are on permanent display at *Jean-Jacques Dutko Gallery* in Paris and *Zoumboulakis Gallery* in Athens.

According to Fernando Botero, "Her sculpture is identifiable by her personal force of expression which achieves the maximum and significant, using the minimum and insignificant".
